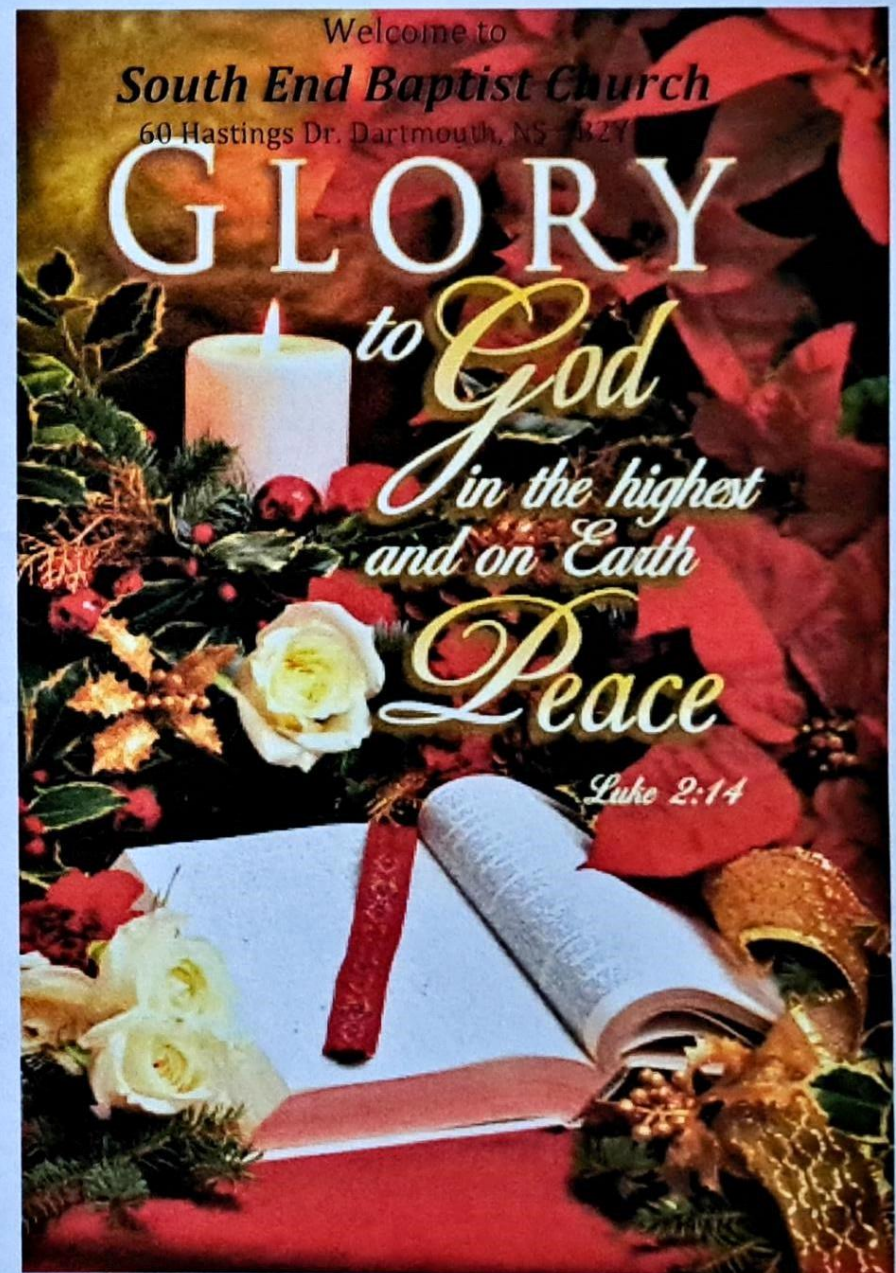
Offering Envelopes

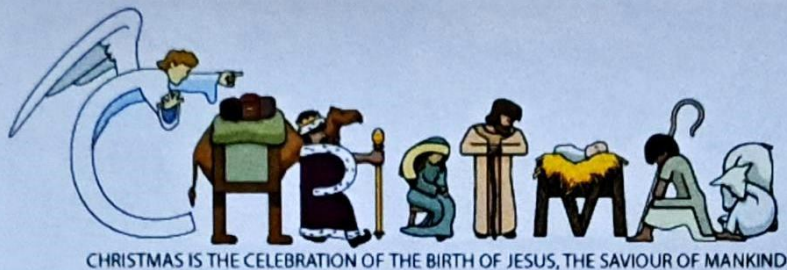
